How to Use This Book.

This book is a tool for you to use in your Bible study. The book of Proverbs is so FULL of wisdom and I wanted a way to compile these nuggets of wisdom to refer to over and over. I also wanted a practical way to study the book of Proverbs with my children. This book is the result. I have been thinking about putting something like this together for a long time, and I finally had a chance to sit down and put down on "paper" what has been in my head. This study can be done individually or as a family. No matter how you decide to use this study, the important thing is that you get in the Word with your children! God has so MUCH to teach us through His Word...and the Proverbs are full of wisdom for us.

Now...for the details of how to use this book: I have chosen 12 topics to be covered over the course of this study (lasting a whole year!). You will study one topic per month, reading through the whole book of Proverbs (one a day), looking for verses pertaining to that topic. Simply read the Proverb that corresponds to the day of the month (e.g. on the 1st day of the month read Proverbs 1.) When you run across a verse that talks about that month's topic, then record it in your journal. During months that don't have 31 days, just choose a day or two to read through two Proverbs. These topics can be studied in order or you can skip around and choose a topic you wish to study for each month. I would encourage you, though, to choose only one topic per month. As the Lord speaks to you and as you learn things about the month's topic, record those things on the page entitled "What I learned about _____ through this study."

I would suggest printing this book single-sided, 3-hole punching, and placing in a 3-ring binder. You could print the topic pages with the check-off chart on cardstock paper and attach a divider tab to them with the names of the topics on the tabs.

I have included a few blank study pages at the end of this book so that you can choose a different topic than those I have provided OR if you want to add more topics to your study. Also, if you need more journal pages to record verses (I have provided 5 for each of the topics), just print out additional pages as you need them.

I pray that the Lord will bless your study of His Word. May this little book be a tool to help you along in your studies and provide a means to record what the Lord is teaching you.
